

OUR CAMPUS

RCA is situated on the east side of Greenville on a 24-acre campus shared between MRPC and the school. We currently occupy three buildings that include one classroom for K3, one for Transitional 1st, and two classrooms each for K4-8th grade. There are art and music rooms, two lunchrooms, the Learning Commons (a multi-functional

library/media center), a Sanctuary, a Fellowship Hall, multiple meeting rooms and offices, a gymnasium with locker rooms and concessions, multiple playgrounds and break areas, soccer fields, and more. All of these spaces are available to and used by MRCA for academic and extracurricular activities both during and outside of the school's operating hours.





SPIRITUAL FORMATION

At MRCA, the privilege to shepherd our students' hearts and minds begins by infusing every part of the school day with the gospel of Jesus Christ. While students have weekly chapel and daily Bible classes, God's truth is woven into each subject, teaching students how to look for that truth in every academic lesson and interaction. Teachers lead MRCA's weekly chapel and bring the Word of God to life, showing students how engaging the Bible is and how it directly applies to their stages of life. Throughout their years here, students will walk through the Bible from Genesis to Revelation, learn how to study the Bible on their own, and how to engage the other world views around them with the truths of the Gospel.



THE HEAD OF SCHOOL ROLE

RESPONSIBILITIES

ORGANIZATIONAL LEADERSHIP

The MRCA Head of School reports to ■ the Board of Directors, which operates under the authority of the Mitchell Road Presbyterian Church's elder board. The Head of School provides overall Christ-centered, biblically based leadership for all aspects of the academy and is responsible for all spiritual, academic, and co-curricular programs, as well as all business operations, which include IT, accounting/finance, communications, security, and building maintenance. The Head of School also serves as a key member of the church's overall leadership team and works in close coordination with the church's pastoral staff.

SPIRITUAL LEADERSHIP

The Head of School provides spiritual ▲ leadership through a powerful Christian testimony and witness, a humble spirit, and a heart guided by prayer. The Head of School is responsible for ensuring students can grow and develop with the foundation of God's truth and for fostering the spiritual vitality of the faculty and staff so they can positively influence students. The Head of School will model a Christ-like attitude and lifestyle and demonstrate compassion, patience, honesty, and wisdom in all interactions with staff, students, parents, board members, and other community members.

ACADEMIC LEADERSHIP

The Head of School provides academic L leadership by directing his or her team in the improvement of instruction, curriculum alignment, supervision of staff, selection of curriculum, and administration of disciplinary action for students and staff. The Head of School is responsible for developing a program of professional development to maximize staff growth, advancement, and academic excellence.

STRATEGIC AND VISIONARY LEADERSHIP

The Head of School provides strategic and ■ visionary leadership for the entire academy to reach the end result objectives established by the Board. He or she collaborates with and supervises the school's administrative leadership team, ensuring they effectively lead all other staff in the accomplishment of strategic goals and initiatives for the purpose of MRCA.

The Head of School is the academy's chief spokesperson and enthusiastically promotes the school, its importance, and its vision of Christian education to the school and church family and throughout the greater Greenville community to enhance MRCA's reputation, increase enrollment, and encourage donor support. The Head of School monitors enrollment trends and seeks to understand what is driving those trends.

Be a strong, "out front", enthusiastic leader who can articulate and promote the culture, value, and vision of Christian education throughout the church and school family, as well as throughout the surrounding community.
- Have the ability to guide Christian discipleship and biblical training programs to not only impart knowledge and structure but also cultivate in students joyful relationships with Jesus Christ that celebrate His grace and sovereignty.

- Possess the management, academic, and organizational leadership abilities needed to encourage and inspire others to do their best work, hold employees accountable to high standards, and carry out long-term plans from inception to successful completion.
- Have the ability to execute the duties and responsibilities of a chief academic/ administrative officer that include (but are not limited to) strategic planning, budget oversight, curriculum management, faculty and staff development, accreditation, fundraising.
